Scholarship Amounts

Two \$4,000 scholarship are available to USF students for the 2024-2025 academic year. Students who receive the DAR scholarship are not eligible for other University or Performance based scholarships including athletic or fine arts. Scholarship recipients will be notified at the end of the spring 2024 semester.

Eligibility

To be eligible for consideration, applicants must:

- Enroll as a full time student for the 2024-2025 academic year (minimum 12 credit hours per semester)
- Major in education or history
- Be a resident of South Dakota
- Complete their sophomore or junior year at the end of the spring 2024 semester
- Preferably be a graduate of a South Dakota high school or home school program

Requirements

Scholarship recipients must attend one meeting of the Mary Chilton Chapter to provide a short synopsis of their background and further goals and attend a Foundation Board Social the fall of 2024. Recipients must also write a thank you note to the DAR Foundation board during the summer of 2024.
